Bruce Uditsky, M.Ed., is currently the Executive Director of the Alberta Association for Community Living. He is recognized as an international advocate and speaker on community inclusion and social justice.

Bruce has served on the boards of numerous community organizations and has been instrumental in the development of a number of unique and innovative community programs. He is a former Board member of the Roeher Institute, Canada's research and social policy institute on developmental disabilities and continues to serve on a wide variety of government task forces and committees. He was a founding member of the Alberta Disabilities Forum, a federation of provincial organizations representing persons with disabilities and the Alberta Provincial Voice for Advocacy and Change, a coalition of provincial organizations representing the interests of Alberta children and families.

Bruce is also an Adjunct Professor, Community Rehabilitation and Disability Studies, University of Calgary. He is the parent of two sons, one of whom has FASD and developmental disabilities.
