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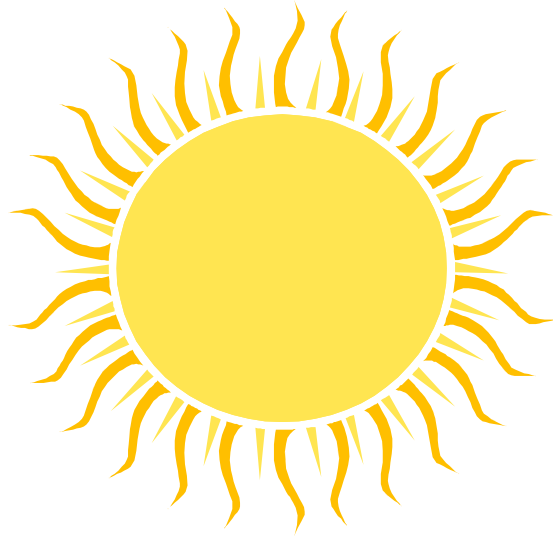

# SOS Summer Program for Children with Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorders (FASD)



The FASD summer camp program is for children between the ages of 5 and 12 with a Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder diagnosis. The summer camp provides children with fun camp experiences as well as opportunities to learn and practice important social skills. Camp experiences include arts and crafts exploration, swimming, park outings and more!

Program time will focus primarily on friendship skills (how to join a group, share, take turns, read body language, etc.) while incorporating sensory strategies to assist children with calming and relaxing. Beginning self-regulation skills will also be taught. Participants will have multiple opportunities to learn the skills through small group settings, interactive lessons, role plays, games and fun activities, followed by opportunities to practice their newly acquired skills.

The program is overseen by coordinators with extensive training in FASD intervention. Children will be assigned a shared aide, trained in best practices for working with children with FASD.

We require that you send your child to camp with the following:

- ♦ lunch (snacks will be provided)
- ♦ a hat
- ♦ sunscreen
- ♦ appropriate outdoor wear
- ♦ indoor shoes
